AllHires uses cookies to provide registered user authentication. If you are experiencing technical problems using the site please check that cookies are enabled in your web browser.

If you are using Internet Explorer 7 we recommend that you update to the most recent version of Internet Explorer.

If your internet browser is **Internet Explorer 9+**:

1. Click the Tools wheel > Internet Options
2. Select Privacy tab then click the Sites button
3. Enter 'Apply4Law.com' into the text box
4. Click Allow
5. Click OK, and OK again
6. Close and re-open your browser

If your internet browser is **Internet Explorer 8**:

1. Select Tools > Internet Options
2. Select Privacy tab then click the Edit or Sites button
3. Enter 'Apply4Law.com' into the text box
4. Click Allow
5. Click OK, and OK again
6. Close and re-open your browser

If your internet browser is **Chrome**:

1. Click the spanner in the top right
2. Choose 'Options'
3. Click on the 'Under the bonnet' tab
4. Under 'Cookie settings', choose 'Allow all cookies'
5. Click Close

If your internet browser is **Firefox 3+**:

1. Select Tools > Options
2. Click on the Privacy tab
3. Choose 'Remember history' or tick 'Accept cookies from sites'
4. Click OK

If your internet browser is **Safari**:

1. Click the Safari menu > preferences
2. Select Security icon
3. Under 'Accept Cookies' choose 'Always' or 'Only from sites you navigate to'
4. Click OK
